Dr. Lina-Maria Murillo: “No Más Bebés”

Join us for a screening of **No Más Bebés**, a powerful documentary that uncovers the untold story of Mexican immigrant women who were forcibly sterilized without consent at Los Angeles County-USC Medical Center during the 1960s and 70s. The film follows their fight for justice in a landmark civil rights case, highlighting issues of reproductive rights, racism, and the lasting impact on these women's lives. Following the screening, there will be a discussion led by **Dr. Lina-Maria Murillo**, Assistant Professor at the University of Iowa, whose research focuses on reproductive politics and borderlands history. Her forthcoming book, *Fighting for Control: Power, Reproductive Care, and Race in the U.S.-Mexico Borderlands*, and her award-winning scholarship will provide critical insight into the historical context of the film.
